#### **A Feminine Victory**

Florence Rankin-Mar 37. NY. Ex-wife of a man Bill knew on Wall Street. Moved to Washington DC to help Fitz. First women to get any significant sobriety time in A.A. Because of her, "One Hundred Men" title not used. Slipped in early 1938. Died of suicide.
